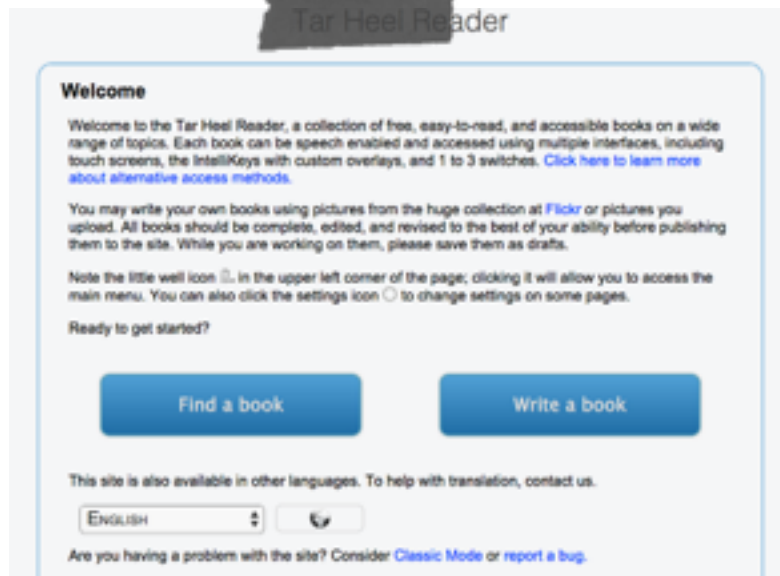

### WAYS TO INTEGRATE

- Write stories about subjects they love
- Use pictures of people they know
- Make them a character in the story
- Write out song lyrics
- Write a story about what going on in their lives-prom, weather, outings

## Task Challenge

Write a book!

1. Use the built in search to find Flickr pictures (or upload your own).
2. When you find a picture you like, click on it. It is added to a page in your book. Repeat for each page. You can change the order of the pages or delete.
3. Provide a title for the book and tags to make it easier to search.
4. Add a simple caption for each picture.
5. When you are done, click on “publish my book” or click on “draft” to work on it later.
6. Read and share your book online or download as an ePub or PowerPoint.
